VLMFSS is looking for youth ages 15-30 preferably from immigrant, refugee, and visible minority families or youth who self-identify as being underrepresented, to join our **Day Camp Program** for children ages 6-12. The successful candidate will be responsible for the planning and implementation of the Day Camp Program.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Planning, coordinating, scheduling, preparing materials, games and activities for the children
- Communicating with parents and other caregivers
- Preparing final reports, including evaluations and reflections of their own experience
- Maintaining budgets and statistics

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
- Demonstrate a high level of energy and enthusiasm
- Experience working with children, ideally in a summer camp setting
- Solid organization and planning skills
- Excellent people and group management skills
- A desire to have fun and be active
- Ability to lead and facilitate activities, games and discussions
- Awareness of cultural diversity and the ability to speak another language is an asset
- Valid First Aid Certification and CPR Certification
- Valid Criminal Record Check, or be willing to obtain one
