Qualifications:

- Cross-cultural counselling skills and experience
- Relevant university degree, e.g. Social Work, Psychology or relevant counselling or related experience
- Effective cross-cultural communication, interpersonal and organizational skills
- Ability to speak and write in English and Korean
- Experience in providing individual and group counselling support
- Experience in advocating on behalf of vulnerable populations
- Knowledge of cross-cultural responsive interactions with staff and clients
- Minimum of 1-year work with families from various ethnic/cultural backgrounds
- Successful completion of Criminal record check

Skills and Attributes:

- Knowledge of dynamics of gender based violence, issues impacting immigrant, refugee and visible minority women and their children
- Ability to liaise and build successful relationships amongst service providers, & work effectively with other professionals in the community
- Acts as a representative of the agency (VLMFSS) in external events and interactions
- Knowledge of relevant resources
- Ability to work flexible hours (**21 hours/week**)
