

In BC there is a Supreme Court, Provincial Court and a Court of Appeal.

Supreme Court hears both civil and criminal cases, as well as some appeals from the Provincial Court.

The Provincial Court hears criminal, criminal youth, family, child protection, small claims and traffic cases.

The Court of Appeal is the highest court in the province, hearing appeals and reviews from the two trial courts as well as appeals and reviews from administrative boards and tribunals
